The secluded, game-rich mountain hunting grounds do not only guarantee a successful hunt, but also offer nature spectacles of a special kind!

Experience – surrounded by a unique mountain backdrop – the lush alpine rose blossom in spring, or the Indian summer in autumn.

The hunting grounds are exclusive high alpine mountain areas. Mountain fitness, good physical condition, health and appropriate equipment are therefore required.

There are hardly any roads accessible by car, and ascents of several hours and stalks up to well over 2.000 m above sea level are the norm.

· GENERAL INFORMATIONEN ·

Prerequisites for hunting in Tyrol

You need a valid domestic hunting licence to obtain the Tyrolean hunting card. Costs for the hunting guest card, valid for 10 days, amount to € 50.

Further requirements are:
A suitable weapon, preferably coordinated, appropriate ammunition, adjusted telescopic sight. A test shot is required prior to the hunt.

Deposit

When taking over the hunted game, we kindly ask to pay the required deposit within 14 days after receipt of delivery.

Shooting

The hunt is an individual hunt. Shooting must be discussed before the hunt and must correspond to the shooting plan.

Shooting can only take place when the game can be targeted and the shot is approved by the hunting guide. There is no entitlement to a certain condition and quality of the trophy.

With the kill, all fees become fully binding, even if the respective game does not meet the expected quality and price.

Trophies

The trophies will be handed over to the hunter after they have been boiled. They become the property of the hunter after full payment of the total fee and presentation at the obligatory trophy show. The hunter shall make the trophies available to the hunting administration at his own expense for presentation at the obligatory trophy show. Sending or collection of the trophies shall be at the expense and risk of the hunter. The game (including the skin) remains with the hunting administration for utilisation. If the trophy needs to be prepared, we are happy to recommend a good address. Boiling of the trophy € 45 (chamois and roe deer), € 105 (red deer).

Stalking fees per day

- Stag: € 150
- Chamois: € 150
- Marmot: € 50
- Black grouse: € 120
- Roebuck: € 150
- Ibex: € 150

Costs per stalk in case of non-success: € 100
Morning or evening stalks for red deer and roe deer: € 80
in case of non-success: € 50

Hunting is possible from a minimum stay of 4 days at the Hotel Falknerhof.

Test shot / Misses / Hunting weapon

Prior to the start of the hunt, at least 2 test shots in the presence of the stalking guide are required. If, for whatever reason, no test shot is taken in the presence of the stalking guide, the fee as stated in the shooting fees will be charged in the event of a miss (game not hit). The use of full metal jacket bullets is not permitted.

Shooting range fee: € 10
Weapon rental: € 50

No-kill shots

To kill game, you should only shoot from the right distance and under ideal conditions. No-kill shots are not appreciated. In such cases, the hunt is interrupted and a search is made using a tracking dog. If wounded game is not found or killed by a hunting guest prior the end of the hunt, the difference between the no-kill charge and the kill charge shall be paid by the shooter; thereafter the trophy is transferred to the shooter. Tracking dogs shall be paid for by the shooter.

Dogs

Taking hunting dogs along requires prior coordination.

Liability

Hunting and moving about within the hunting area is at the hunter's own risk.

Hunting checklist

- Shoes suitable for the high mountains, clothing suitable for mountain hunting
- Pocket knife
- Warm jacket, coat
- Rucksack with a capacity of at least 35 litres
- First aid kit
- Binoculars
- Hunting / mountain pole
- Sufficient ammunition
- Spare clothing
- European firearms and hunting licence
- Gloves
- Hat, no matter what the season
- Headlamp and spare batteries
- Beverages – or thermos flask


Please note that even in July or August there is a possibility of snowfall in our mountain region.

In Austria, hunting is based on an old tradition of Germanic origin.

We never hunt for the sake of shooting or killing game. Our hunting philosophy is based on the search for game, the stalk, the right approach, and only then on the kill.

A word of advice to hunters

Respect local customs. A hunter, even if he carries a rifle or his game, is always welcome in Tyrol.
